RULE NO.2 OF 2019 ON YOUNG DESIGNERS FORUM

- 1.** The Young Designers Forum (YDF) is an established subsidiary of the Association of Designers of Kenya vide its Constitution.
- 2.** The Forum brings together talented young designers of below 35 years of age for a review and discussion on various issues pertaining design practice in Kenya.
- 3.** The Forum seeks to among others; establish a cohesive community of Young Design professionals who create experiences that connect people by undertaking various tailor-made mentoring activities that will help in establishing a strong future design family.
- 4.** It is open to members of Mentorship Programme who must be in the final year of their undergraduate training program as well as Graduate and Technician Members of the Association.
- 5.** The forum is a multi-disciplinary network of designers, industry and technology specialists, educators, and students dedicated to experiential design practice.
- 6.** The forum creates a pool of Young Qualified Design professionals where professional designers and directors review and discuss the Young Designers' work.
